Year 11 Prom 2019

This year's prom for Year 11 will be held on **Friday, 5 July 2019 at The Holiday Inn, Garforth**. We warmly welcome students to this celebration from **6.00pm** where they will be met by Temple Moor staff. There will be a professional photographer available throughout the evening and photographs can be paid for and taken home on the night.

The cost of the ticket is **£35.00**, which includes a three-course dinner, a DJ and disco. There will also be a non-alcoholic bar. The event will finish at 11:30 pm and staff will remain at the venue to supervise students until 12:00 am, therefore, please ensure arrangements for picking up your son/daughter by midnight are in place. The dress code for the event is black tie/smart dress. **No jeans or trainers.**

We respectfully request that students do not smoke on the premises or within the grounds. The consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited and should anybody be found to have been drinking alcohol, will be refused admittance and parents will be required to come and collect them. No refunds will be given.

As in previous years, whether or not students will be eligible to attend will be at the Senior Leadership's discretion, based on a number of factors outlined below:

- Students must have attendance above **97%** and not be persistently late. (No more than 2 days missed unless medical evidence is provided)
- Punctuality to school and lessons will be closely monitored. Students must not exceed more than **6** lates between **25 February and 24 May 2019**.
- Students who regularly miss detentions, or are placed in seclusion more than **2** occasions or persistently refuse to follow school rules **will not be invited** to the prom.
- No more than 1 Principal late detention
- 1 Seclusion maximum
- 2 phase 4's maximum
