Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to provide you with the outline of how the Maths Faculty are planning to begin an assessment cycle involving your child in Year 11. These assessments will form the basis of the evidence required to support any predicted grade.

Over the coming weeks, all students will have the opportunity to complete a number of assessments covering content your child has been taught in Maths during their time with us.

To help with preparing your child for these upcoming assessments, we actively encourage students to use all revision aids at their disposal including revision guides/notes and practice exam questions. To further support your child, we will be offering students weekly period 6 sessions; 're-visit content' lessons; and online video resources for students to watch at home.

The assessments will take place the weeks commencing:

- 29th March Non-Calculator Paper 1
- 19th April Non-Calculator Paper 2
- 26th April Calculator Paper 1
- 3rd May Calculator Paper 2
- 10th May Calculator Paper 3
- 17th May Calculator Paper 4

All papers will be 40 minutes in length and will be completed during your child's normal timetabled Maths lessons.
