Dear Student/Parent/Carer

Firstly, thank you for applying for a place for Temple Moor's Summer Camp. We have 182 students attending across the 2-week period, so the camp will be a good opportunity for you to meet new students from your year group and start to building relationships with other students and staff.

Students will use the main entrance, via Selby Road at the front of school to access the school site while attending the summer camp. Students will also leave via this entrance. Students will be able to arrive at school from 8.30am, and the taught sessions will start at 9.00am. The camp will finish at 3pm when students will be able to leave the school site and make their own way home.

09.00-10.30 - Session 1
10.30-11.00 - Break 1
11.00-12.30 - Session 2
12.30-13.45 - Lunch
13.45-15.00 - Session 3

There are a range of activities taking place across the 2 weeks, including STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) Sport, Baking, Music, Performance and Drama, Dance, Teambuilding, Bushcraft, Time trials and an Assault Course. Students will engage with a wide range of these activities across the 2 weeks. The activities are not repetitive and are highly practical, this is to support social interaction and help students create effective and long-lasting relationships.

During break 1 students will be offered a piece of fruit, at lunch they will be offered a grab bag, this will include a sandwich, cake and juice box. Anyone who has a specific dietary need such as vegetarian will be catered for, if this was specified on your application. There will be a mix of sandwiches available such as ham, tuna, cheese, these will vary each day, but we cannot guarantee one choice of sandwich. You are of course also welcome to send a packed lunch for students. We run a completely cashless system at Temple Moor, there will not be a tuck shop or any opportunity to buy food in school, so please make sure you have what you need for the day. Please ensure students bring their own water bottle – we have water fountains and will provide jugs of water for students to refill their water bottles throughout the day.

Students will be outside for some of their sessions, and the sessions will have many practical elements. Please ensure that students are appropriately dressed (tracksuit bottoms, leggings, shorts and a t-shirt/jumper). Please ensure that you also consider the weather – students will be allowed to wear hats outdoors if it is exceptionally hot and would need to have sun cream on/with them for protection throughout the day.

We will call the contact provided if students do not attend on a day, we are expecting them. If a student is going to be absent, please leave a message on the school absence line 0113 3900770 ext. 222. Although we are heading towards the roadmap to recovery as a country, we still need to be cautious around Covid, and ensure we limit the spread where possible. Please do not attend the camp if you display any of the symptoms of Covid and notify the school should you display symptoms. Track and trace would now inform close contacts of students, but we would still appreciate you contacting us should a student need to self-isolate.



We expect the highest level of behaviour at Temple Moor, we will be putting in a behaviour system for the summer school, this usually remains unused as students meet our expectations, but has to be in place to support staff and other students. Should a student's behaviour need to be addressed in a session they will be given a verbal warning, followed by 3 following notices to improve behaviour. If a student fails at this point, they will be removed from the session and serve timeout with the camp leader. If a student has to do this on more than one occasion, then the emergency contact would be called and asked to pick the student up from school. If a student is removed from a lesson on more than 1 day within a week, the emergency contact will be asked to collect the student and they will no longer be able to return to the camp.

We are looking forward to meeting you all on the Summer Camp.
