### Remote Learning Update

Changes to Government regulations mean fewer students should face disruption to their learning, nonetheless, we are still very much committed to maintaining students' access and entitlement to the full curriculum, should they be required to self-isolate.

Where this is the case, all remote learning for years 7 to 11 will be set on Class Charts so that, not only students, but parents and carers too can view and monitor completion by students. For this reason, we encourage all students, parents and carers to download the Class Charts app on to their mobile and tablet devices (view video tutorials [here](#) and guides [here](#)).

Tutors will go through our Class Charts tutorials and guides in form-time to remind students how to navigate these platforms; re-issuing login details where necessary. In the case of our new year 7 intake, ICT lessons this half-term will also demonstrate the use of Class Charts to increase students' familiarity and confidence with this platform.

As confirmation of a student's need to isolate is shared with school, all students will be required to engage with English, Maths and Science learning on [EdClass](#) for the initial 24-hour period only. Further details on how this can be accessed are shared below and will be added to our website. After this initial period, arrangements will vary slightly by Key Stage:

- **Key Stage Three** - Students in years 7, 8 and 9 will be added to a 'Self-isolating students' group on Class Charts with remote learning issued or every subject at the start of the week
- **Key Stage Four - Remote learning will be issued by subject teachers at the start of each week**
- **Key Stage Five - All lessons will be delivered LIVE over Microsoft TEAMS as per the student's normal timetable**

Our remote learning provision ensures that the learning set for all students provides clarity of explanation, modelling, scaffolding and feedback; educational research shows that it is these elements of effective teaching which best support progress with remote learning. Additionally, remote learning for all year groups will feature audio commentary from teaching staff to best support students.



Where a student has any concerns about their remote learning, please encourage them to contact their class teacher via the Class Charts messaging system so they can receive a direct response.

### Accessing EdClass:

EdClass can be accessed [here](#) and must be accessed through a Google Chrome browser only.

Login details for all students are as follows:

- **School ID** - Temple-Moor
- **Username** - Their first and last names with no gap, e.g. JosephBloggs
- **Password** - Their date of birth with no gaps and the full year, e.g. 01012021
- The learning on this platform has been set by teachers from each department, this ensures the learning students engage with on the first day of self-isolation is fully aligned to the Scheme of Learning being delivered in class.
- Whilst completing work on here for the first 24-hour period, students should still direct their queries to their class teachers through Class Charts.
